Cybersecurity: Protects Internet-Connected Systems from Cyber-Threats

- Protects Hardware, Software and Data
- Applies to Vehicle Networks and Related Networked Infrastructure

These Same 3 Precautions Apply to Cybersecurity!

Cybersecurity Has Additional Challenges

- Networked Environments & Attack Points
 - Difficult to Isolate a Single Computer or Vehicle ECU
- New Viruses Always Being Introduced
 - Many Antivirus Solutions Are Available, but Not Used
 - New Viruses Daily, Some Have No Immediate Antivirus
 - Most are Immediate, Some Designed to Incubate, then Attack
- Many Other Threats, Beyond Viruses:
 - Malware: Malicious Software to Harm Computer Resources
 - Include worms, computer viruses, Trojan horses and spyware
 - Ransomware: Malware Attacks Locking Computer System Files
 - Typically Using Encryption and Demanding \$ to Unlock Them
 - Social Engineering: Uses Human Interaction to Trick Users
 - Users Breaking Security Procedures, e.g. Email Phishing
 - Allows Access to Sensitive Information that is Typically Protected

Computer Viruses Can Be:

- Spread over Networks
- Distributed by Physical Contact
 - Storage Media
 - e.g. USB Flash Drives
 - External Devices, When Attached to a Vehicle or Computer
 - e.g. Vehicle Diagnostic Adapters
 - One Infection Can Spread to Infect Many!
 - Compromise Many Computer Systems or Vehicle ECUs
